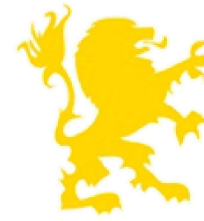

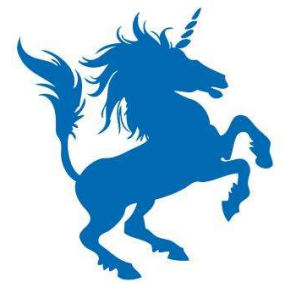
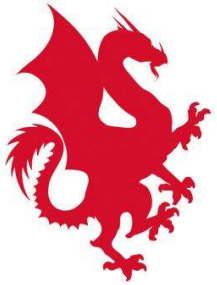

What we know about exams?

Comparative outcomes determine the number of students who get each grade

Grade 9s are hard to get – a grade 9 in the year 10 mock does not guarantee a grade 9 overall

Students must be continuously working and revising

Grade boundaries get moved – some by 15 to 20 marks

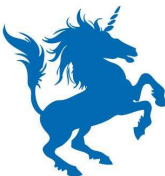

Truancy

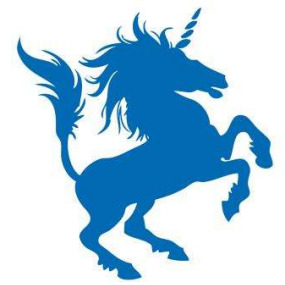
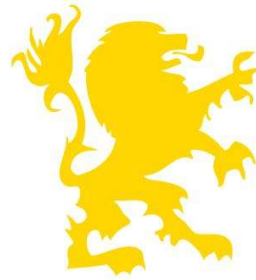
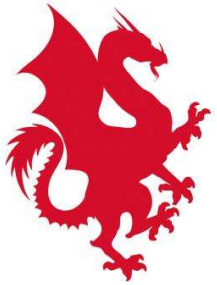
- Refusal to attend timetabled session AND refusal to follow instructions from staff.

1. Truancy 1 - SLT zone (parent call)
2. Truancy 2 - SLT zone (parent meeting)
3. Truancy 3 – TATE (parent call)
4. Truancy 4 – TATE (parent meeting)
5. Truancy 5 – Suspension (reintegration meeting)
6. Any further incidents of truancy - suspension

Mock results matter...

- They will determine sets
- Which will determine tier of entry in some subjects
- Which will impact on what can be studied post 16



Target Grades

- Will be used as a reference for progress
- Based on data from year 7
- They are the minimum expectation not a ceiling on performance
- Target grades won't change on the system, but a teacher may change if consistently working above

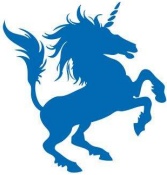

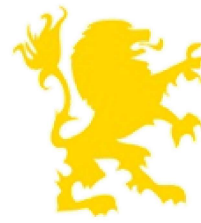
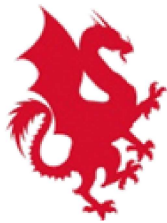
